A compulsory work component is one that you must complete as part of your course requirements and is officially registered on CRICOS.

Only compulsory CRICOS-registered placements are exempt.



The hours you work in this internship/placement **DO** count towards the 48-hour work limit.

- Paid work experience



REMEMBER

All work (paid or unpaid) counts towards your 48-hour limit if it is not a compulsory CRICOS-registered component of your course.



Work limits for Student visa (subclass 500)

You can generally work a maximum of 48 hours per fortnight while your course is "in session".



What is counted as work?

Paid work, unpaid work, internships and placements are all considered work under your visa conditions.
